

**BACKGROUND:**

Spring Hill Sports Association, Inc. has requested to put a shed over at Fischer Park to hold all of their equipment. It is very cumbersome for them to haul everything back and forth every single day and we no longer have room in the shop at Fischer Park. We have asked them to sign a liability waiver because we know that the park floods from time to time. We have chosen a spot that is the least likely to get wet but it could still happen. The City Attorney has provided the attached MOU and the Hawks have signed it. Spring Hill Sports Association, Inc. will be paying for the shed and all necessary construction to place it.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
BETWEEN THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE,  
AND SPRING HILL SPORTS ASSOCIATION, INC.

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is dated April 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2022, and executed by and between the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee ("City") and Spring Hill Sports Association, Inc. ("Spring Hill Hawks"), memorializing the agreement of even date.


The Spring Hill Hawks has approached the City seeking permission to locate a shed at Fischer Park to store sporting equipment owned by the Spring Hill Hawks. The City is agreeable to permitting the storage shed in Fischer Park pursuant to the following conditions, to-wit:

1. The design, size and materials of the shed must be approved by the City Administrator or her designee before being placed in Fischer Park.
2. The shed must be place in a mutually agreeable location in Fischer Park.
3. The Spring Hill Hawks is responsible for furnishing, installing and maintaining the shed at no cost and no risk to the City whatsoever.
4. Any and all items stored in the shed are at the sole risk of the Spring Hill Hawks. Known risks include, but are not limited to, flooding, vandalism and theft.
5. The Spring Hill Hawks agree to hold the City harmless for any damage or loss to the shed and/or its contents.
6. The shed is subject to removal by the City with thirty (30) days' written notice to the Spring Hill Hawks and no compensation whatsoever.

In acknowledgment hereof, the parties have executed this MOU on the day and date first above written.


