**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE EMERGENCY REPAIR FOR FIRE
DEPARTMENT ENGINE 63**

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill Fire Department has identified an issue with Engine 63 and have to get it repaired as soon as possible before it causes further harm; and

WHEREAS, the mechanic has looked at the fire apparatus and determined the rings in the engine need to be replaced. This is causing excessive crank case pressure and it is blowing oil out of the engine; and

WHEREAS, fixing this apparatus will help us keep providing that high level of customer service to our citizens on the North side of the city; and

WHEREAS, while Engine 63 is in the repair shop, our reserve engine will be placed into service. There will not be a drop-in service to our citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen approve this repair to the engine on Engine 63 at a cost of \$11,829.92.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this resolution is to approve the repair request on the engine on Engine 63. Per the mechanic, the rings are worn out on the engine. This is causing excessive crank case pressure to build and blow oil out of the motor.

BACKGROUND:

Engine 63 is fire engine for station 3 on Campbell Station. This apparatus protects the northern side of our city. While it is out of service, we will have our reserve engine in-service at fire station 3.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Funding for this will come out of our maintenance line-item number 110-42200-261. We currently have it in our budget to cover this cost. The quote is \$11,829.92 for the repair.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of Resolution 22-58 for emergency repair of the engine on Engine 63 repaired.
