SECTION 1. That the City of Spring Hill is hereby authorized to submit application for a “Safety Partners” Matching Grant through Public Entity Partners (PEP).


SECTION 2. That the City of Spring Hill is further authorized to provide a matching sum of up to \$4,000.00 to serve as a match for any monies provided by this grant.
