**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE DISPOSAL OF DECOMMISSIONED
POLICE VEHICLES**

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Alderman authorized the Spring Hill Police Department to purchase police vehicles in years past; and

WHEREAS, the purchased vehicles listed below are older model vehicles with high mileage; and

WHEREAS, the Spring Hill Police Department requests to advertise the listed vehicles for sale on Gov Deals and or donate to local police departments in need of vehicles to be used for law enforcement purposes; and

WHEREAS, the following vehicles are recommended to be sold at auction (Gov Deals) or donated:


