

RESOLUTION 23-11

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AN EMERGENCY EXPENDITURE FOR A TRAFFIC SIGNAL POLE REPAIR

WHEREAS, the traffic signal pole located at the intersection of Main Street and Buckner Road was significantly damaged in a traffic vehicle accident on June 21, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the damage to the pole resulted in a hazard to the health and wellbeing of citizens travelling through this intersection which required immediate remediation; and

WHEREAS, an insurance claim was filed and reimbursement has been received in the amount of \$23,500; and

WHEREAS, the City contracted with S&W Contracting Company Inc. for the emergency repairs for a cost of \$26,000.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen approves the emergency expenditure in the amount of \$26,000 to S&W Contracting Company Inc. for a traffic signal pole repair at the intersection of Main Street and Buckner Road.

PURPOSE:

To approve an emergency expenditure for a traffic signal pole repair at the intersection of Main Street and Buckner Road

BACKGROUND:


A traffic signal pole was damaged in a traffic accident on June 21, 2022. Due to the significant damage caused, the traffic signal pole presented a danger to citizens travelling through this intersection. Therefore, an emergency repair was required. The City contracted with S&W Contracting Company Inc to repair the pole the same day of the accident. The total repair cost is \$26,000. The City filed an insurance claim for the repair and has received \$23,500 in insurance reimbursement.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The net cost to the City is \$2,500 (the cost of the repairs less the City's deductible).

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of Resolution 23-11, to approve an emergency expenditure for a traffic signal pole repair at the intersection of Main Street and Buckner Road.
